When providing an answer, tell a personal story that gives an example about the quality of your work or addresses the question



Be structured when answering a question and don't be afraid to think out loud. We're curious about how you get to a solution.



Always ask for clarification if you don't understand a question and feel free to take the time you need before you respond. You should feel comfortable asking questions anytime throughout the interview.
